Ozonics Scent Eliminator: Highly recommended for those of you who are focused on scent control! Which should be everyone. © This can be a game changer for your hunt! There are various models to choose from. Although they last several days without washing depending on intensity of activity, we recommend several layers you can rotate and wear though the week. 100% Merino Wool Socks: Another great item to help control scent. Good socks are another component of scent control and being comfortable in the stand. I have sweated in these and your feet don't stink at the end of the day because bacteria can't replicate like it can on other cheaper hunting socks.
